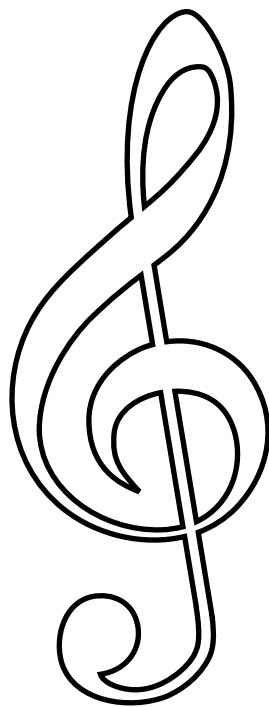

Badyn Woodford is a senior at Saint Clairsville High School, where he has dedicated 5 years to playing with the award-winning “Red Devil” Marching Band and Saint Clairsville High School’s Jazz Band, among other ensembles, including his high school’s concert band. Badyn is a devoted multi-instrumentalist who has studied the piano for 14 years (under Ms. Linda Steffl, Dr. Gerald Lee, and Dr. Millard Neal), the trombone for 8 years (under Mr. Justin Schwertfeger and Mr. Evan Robinson), and the organ for 6 years (under Dr. Millard Neal). Badyn regularly serves as an organist for a number of churches in the Ohio Valley, and the surrounding area.

Badyn’s commitment to music study has manifested through his election to perform trombone in multiple honors ensembles, including the West Liberty Tri-State Honors Ensemble, the OVAC All-Star Marching Band, and the Macy’s Great American Marching Band. His dedication has also presented opportunities to perform as an organist in historic venues across the country. Badyn hopes to further his commitment through regular musical performances in the years to come, and consistent dedication to growing his craft. Following graduation, he will pursue a BM in Music Education at West Virginia University.
